Use a chisel in the stone, but now we get a chance to type on these pocket computer and, you know, laptops and using technology that gives us an opportunity to truly document what we are doing and create, I got a message earlier and it looks like a transcript from whether it was a conference call from here or from publishing, but just technology is amazing and our words to man, it is powerful, I do not want to babble along, but definitely want to give Mr. Hall opportunity to share and just continue this thing tank with 2 or more gathered here is here in the midst and wonderful things will come.

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Okay. Well, I appreciate again the the time you have set aside to have this discussion, I will give you a little historical background for myself. I have worked for NASA when I first started out coming out of I was out of school and worked for the Department of Defense for a number of years and traveled to many military bases And was part of a tactical systems development and deployment team that had access to the Pentagon Tonto different other military bases. So my my technology skill set in terms of states a ranges from all the way back to when the cat was being transitioned to the transistor. So that is that is the foundation of my my my technical Knowledge and exposure. Ultimately, I ended up after many years working in that field, I starting a building maintenance company in Colorado Springs that did very well formed a collaborative partnership with 1 of the nation's largest wholesale distributors.

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That distributed office supplies and and cleaning supplies to over 10,000 local supply companies in the country. So I had created an online catalog. It is called Flexnet, FLX NT and place all of their products on that electronic catalog. And that was before the coms bomb, but obviously the coms bombing. Well, that that have impacted what my wife and I were doing at the time in a moment. You will you will find out why I am I am giving this sort of background, but ultimately the experience of having a successful business and knowing how to create revenue and employed over 140 employees from to different cities in Colorado, I learned a few things along the way and part of what I learned was that it takes stick tuitiveness and a determination to and an appreciation for the vision you have.

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That in order for you to actually do to succeed at anything, if you do not have a vision, you can have no place to go and so ultimately when.coms bombed and took the made and a half dollar investment that my wife put in in the Flexnet program. We had to rediscover reinvent ourselves and to take a track to go further, ultimately I in because of my technology understanding, I was able to develop a couple of platforms and 1 of those platforms I want to talk to you about today. Yeah. And and and we are actually 2 of them I want to mention the first 1 is a is the facility access and facility as net is a directory that I created the 2017. But when I started out, I only had like 30 summon members on that directory today on a worldwide scale, we have over 100,000 companies that have joined us and have become part of the facility access family because I lost my wife to death about 18 months ago.

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I have I have had to change some things in my life obviously that impacted how I could construct my thinking at my age right now at 75 here shortly. I have been looking for a way. And to find young persons with whom I could share my experience and gift the technology that I have to them so that they ultimately can then take that technology in the success associated with it, move it forward and have and hopefully find success in this application. I found a young lady in California. And she has joined with me in a memorandum of understanding behalf to be a partner in the flex program. And so now the technology I have placed under her complete jurisdiction, I support her to do the things she needs to do in the background, I have supported her handwriting proposals to the state of California, a number of things along those lines.

And and the other is called the Honuatree Program, a technology that really is a part of this discussion. So I am giving you a track record in a pattern of direction I have been taking over the years. Han was initially developed to provide educators the opportunity to hang out their shingles, to provide tutoring support services to students who are having difficulty establishing themselves, let us just say in short terms at risk youth and there. In Colorado, my wife and I, we created a program there which got approved by the state of California, Colorado, excuse me, and operated with the local nonprofit there, and I ran for 3 years in that state. So I have taken that model that experience in Colorado replicated it and and branded it who knew a tree and which is now the program that I am talking to you about now.

Again, using a backdrop of my my age, my health, the loss of my wife and and having had the privilege of meeting Wayne, he and I formed a collaboration that will place this technology under his direct administration control and that is really where we are today, we have submitted a proposal to the state of Illinois. And and there is some things have changed over the past several years. And among the things that have changed is that the tre original proposal I created in Colorado was not applicable across the board to all other states. So we were not successful at this round to receive the application approval for the state of Illinois to provide the education services we wanted to there, but what that led us to is this, again, keeping your mind open to changes and recognizing the things that are taking place around you, we decided not to throw the baby out of the bath order.



And I am humbled to tell you I have more than I do not know. 7 phone lines + 800 numbers to include facts. It cost me less than a 100 bucks. That is what a financial analyst is supposed to do. 
